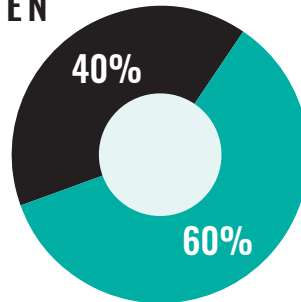

MBA in Impact Management

The only degree of its kind in Israel, the MBA in Impact Management prepares graduates to lead financially successful ventures that contribute to the common social good. In other words, Doing Good by Doing Well.

BSN for Haredi Men

Over 100 Ultra-Orthodox Men are enrolled in the School of Nursing Science. This unique degree allows students to become fully certified nurses while studying in a religiously sanctioned environment. To date, the program has over 130 graduates.

Scholarships for Arab Master's Psychology Students

Established to address the severe shortage of Arabic-speaking Psychologists, this program gives full scholarships and generous **living stipends to 20 students every year.**

The Tel Aviv-Yaffo Future Coders Course

25 of Yaffo's brightest Arab high school students enroll in a programming course at the College and earn credit towards their B.Sc. The goal of the program is to increase Arab representation in the high tech sector.

Community Counseling

Master's Psychology students and their professors transform a nearby community park into an informal clinical setting. New parents are able to voice their struggles and concerns and the students are able to offer helpful tips for their "parent patients" gaining important clinical experience while serving their community.
