ISRAEL NEEDS NURSES

Established in 2012 in response to an urgent call from the Ministry of Health for qualified medical professionals, the School of Nursing Science combines rigorous theoretical studies with clinical training in leading hospitals and healthcare centers. Our degrees are adapted to meet the needs of students from across the spectrum of Israeli society. These diverse students benefit from a world-class faculty, partnerships with leading medical centers, and hands-on experience using the innovative technologies shaping nursing in the twenty-first century.

OUR DEGREES

Whether an army medic, a Torah scholar, or a working mother, our programs, all fully accredited by the Ministry of Health, are designed to meet the diverse needs of over 600 students.

B.S.N. - BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN NURSING

Established in 2012, this four-year track provides nursing students with a strong theoretical foundation and significant clinical experience. This combination equips graduates with the skills needed to work as nurses and the analytical capacity needed for further study throughout their careers.

B.S.N. FOR HAREDI MEN

Established in 2013, our flagship program merges the rigor of a nationally recognized nursing program with the accommodations necessary for Haredi men to fulfill their religious obligations. This four-year program bolsters Israel's medical infrastructure with fully qualified nurses, promotes significant social progress in Israeli society, and generates transformative economic opportunity for the Haredi community, both for those at the outset of their careers and for those seeking to transition out of a religiously based work.

FAST TRACK PROGRAM FOR NON-B.S.N. ACADEMICS

Established in 2018, this three-year degree is designed to accommodate professionals looking for a career change. We provide focused, flexible training for those whose personal and professional responsibilities would otherwise prevent them from studying full-time. This program allows non-traditional students to transition into a respected, well-paying profession without sacrificing their short-term stability.

M.A. IN NURSING

Established in 2024, this two-year program equips nursing professionals with advanced knowledge of the health system. The curriculum emphasizes research methodologies, health policy, management, and leadership to prepare graduates to address current and future challenges in the Israeli health system.

40% of students are Israeli-Arabs

Over 140 Haredi students have graduated since the program was established

95% of the first Fast Track graduating class passed their national certification exam
